Description

Province-wide spatial data demonstrating lands in the province that are occupied by land tenures unrelated to the mining sector – referred to as non-mining land tenures. There are two types of non-mining land tenures: leases and patents. These tenures can have mining rights only, surface rights only, or both mining and surface rights. All non-mining land tenures have a unique ID and are represented by a single polygon. Polygons may or may not overlap. Gaps within and between polygons are allowed.
