Description

This dataset provides province-wide legacy spatial data that shows lands that have been registered as mining claims before the provincial grid was created. A boundary claim is formed by the conversion of one or more parts of a legacy claim that falls within a cell on the provincial grid. It is important to note that boundary claims are a product of conversion/legacy claims and cannot be registered in MLAS; only cell claims can be registered. No new boundary claims will ever be created. Existing boundary claims convert to regular cell claims when all other boundary claims in the same cell on the provincial grid are cancelled. Polygons must not overlap but gaps within and between polygons are allowed.
