Description

Province-wide tabular data listing lands that have been registered as a mining claim and the corresponding cell(s) on the provincial grid. A mining claim in the *Operational_Cell_Claims.shp* spatial file is represented by one polygon. The provincial grid spatial file is comprised of rectangular cells that form a grid. Each cell is represented by one polygon and has a unique identification number that can be used to determine the location of mining interests. All mining claim geometries since the launch of MLAS in 2018 align with the provincial grid cells. *Operational_Cell_Claims.shp* may overlap multiple cells on the provincial grid. This CSV file can be joined tabularly to the *Operational_Cell_Claims.shp* spatial file using the field *TENURE_NUM* and used to determine the locations of mining claims on the provincial grid.
